Advice to Young Men

Paterson takes up where she left off in 1990 with more than 550 annotated citations covering the Fall of 1990 through the Summer of 1997. Those seven years, framed by the Anabolic Steroids Control Act of 1990 and the controversial *Vernonica v. Acton* decision upholding the constitutionality of random, suspicionless drug testing of public high school athletes, were particularly important to those involved in the sports/steroids issue. Paterson covers articles that discuss the physical, emotional, and behavioral aspects of steroid use. She emphasizes substantial review articles, human research studies, and use surveys, and includes such topics as drug education and prevention efforts, the superhormones DHEA and melatonin, and alternatives to steroids that athletes can use to enhance their training. Each entry includes complete bibliographic information, and an annotation.

Face to Face

Throughout the world, healthcare professionals often lack knowledge of the possibilities and limitations of systematically processing data, information and knowledge and of the resulting impact on quality decision-making. They are often asked to use information technologies of which they have limited appreciation, in order to enhance their practices through better use of information resources. However, for systematically processing data, information and knowledge in medicine and in healthcare, healthcare professionals who are well-trained in medical informatics or health informatics are needed. It will only be through improved education of healthcare professionals and through an increase in the number of well-trained workers in health and medical informatics that this lack of knowledge and associated skills can begin to be reversed. Although we can recognize further progress in educating health and a considerable number of educational programs for health informatics / medical informatics specialists have been set up, there is still a need to enhance these educational activities world wide, considering global developments as well as new curricular concepts and technological opportunities. IMIA and in particular its working group on health and

medical informatics education is the leading international society stimulating such educational activities in various ways. This book is especially helpful for educators in the field of health / medical informatics.

Earth date, August 11, 1997 "Beam me up Scottie!" "We cannot do it! This is not Star Trek's Enterprise. This is early years Earth." However, restricting access stations to physical location limits the boundary of the vision.
