Ce volume couvre les années 1899-1902, soit la majeure partie de la législature durant laquelle Jean Jaurès ne siège pas au Parlement. Son activité n'a pas pour autant perdu en intensité, ni pris un tour plus modéré, au moment où son engagement pour Dreyfus s'élargit et se transforme en soutien au gouvernement de Défense républicaine et en combat pour l'unité socialiste. Au contraire : il lutte sur deux fronts, contre la droite et contre ceux des socialistes qui ne croient guère aux conquêtes légales et progressives, par l'action gouvernementale et la voie parlementaire. L'énergie de Jaurès ne s'absorbe pas tout entière dans la direction de la Petite République ni dans des articles d'actualité politique. Jaurès retrouve le temps de la recherche, des lectures et de la réflexion théoriques et historiques. Elles le ramènent vers les deux grandes sources d'inspiration que sont alors pour tout socialiste la Révolution française et l'œuvre de Karl Marx. De ce travail inlassable naissent deux grandes œuvres, l'Histoire socialiste de la Révolution française et les Études socialistes (on trouvera ici la réédition complète de ce dernier ouvrage). La relation entre socialisme et démocratie, la question de la propriété, le dialogue avec la social-démocratie allemande : il n'est aucun des sujets abordés qui ne trouve un écho dans les débats de notre temps. L'édition, la présentation et l'annotation de ce volume sont dues à Maurice Agulhon, professeur honoraire au Collège de France, président d'honneur de la Société d'études jaurésiennes, et à Jean-François Chanet, professeur à l'Institut d'études politiques de Paris, vice-président de la Société d'études jaurésiennes.

Here is the first scholarly study of the life and thought of Benoît Malon (1841-1893), the most persuasive and visible spokesman for reformist socialism during the early years of the French Third Republic. Active in the generation of the French Left that came of age under the Second Empire, Malon was a prominent member of the First International in Paris and later joined the Paris Commune. As a result, he was forced into exile in Switzerland and Italy during the 1870s, where he became entangled in the struggles within the International. Malon attempted to steer a course between Marxist authoritarianism and anarchist utopianism, which he continued on his return to France in 1880. Vincent analyzes Malon's role as activist, editor, and author, arguing that Malon drew on a strong tradition of left-wing French republicanism. In his mature works, Malon articulated a socialism that emphasized broad moral and socioeconomic reform and advocated parliamentary rule as the appropriate source of national sovereignty. In helping the republican socialist Left shed its revolutionary associations, he pointed the way for later reformist socialists from Jean Jaurès to François Mitterrand.

Jean Jaurès was a towering intellectual and political leader of the democratic Left at the turn of the twentieth century, but he is little remembered today outside of France, and his contributions to political thought are little studied anywhere. In *Jean Jaurès: The Inner Life of Social Democracy*, Geoffrey Kurtz introduces Jaurès to an American audience. The parliamentary and philosophical leader of French socialism from the 1890s until his assassination in 1914, Jaurès was the only major socialist leader of his generation who was educated as a political philosopher. As he championed the reformist method that would come to be called social democracy, he sought to understand the inner life of a political tradition that accepts its own imperfection. Jaurès's call to sustain the tension between the ideal and the real resonates today. In addition to recovering the questions asked by the first generation of social democrats, Kurtz's aim in this book is to reconstruct Jaurès's political thought in light of current theoretical and political debates. To achieve this, he gives readings of several of Jaurès's major writings and speeches, spanning work from his early adulthood to the final years of his life, paying attention to not just what Jaurès is saying, but how he says it.

L'analyse du vocabulaire utilise par Jean Jaurès dans "Etudes socialistes", recueil d'articles publié en 1901, permet de dégager plusieurs caractéristiques importantes de sa rhétorique. Celle-ci apparaît comme le contraire d'un jeu gratuit et ornemental. Elle est une rhétorique du dialogue, attentive à la présence de toutes les voix qui se croisent dans le discours, celles des lecteurs, celles des adversaires et aussi celles des témoins que Jaurès appelle constamment à la barre pour les faire intervenir dans le débat. Elle remplit les deux fonctions qu'on attribue traditionnellement au discours politique, la fonction polémique et la fonction didactique. Elle est enfin une rhétorique de l'action, soucieuse d'efficacité, parce qu'elle propose sans cesse à ses lecteurs l'image d'un monde en train de se transformer et à la construction duquel ils doivent participer.
