Note that all the above verses use the Greek word entole (pronounced en-tol-ay) that is always used when referring to the Ten Commandments in the New Testament, thus one can see how God feels about our loving obedience to His law. 1 John 5:3 "For this is the love of God, that we keep his Commandments: and his Commandments are not grievous.

## **Modern-day Paraphrase of the Ten Commandments**

The Ten Commandments are essentially a summary of the 613 commandments contained in the Old Testament Law. The first four commandments deal with our relationship with God. The last six commandments deal with our relationships with one another. The Ten Commandments are recorded in the Bible in Exodus 20:1-17 and Deuteronomy 5:6-21 and are as

The third column presents the Ten Commandments given by Augustine of Hippo (354-430 AD), who reasoned that "graven images" were an equivalent of "other gods" and considered Exodus 20:4 as part of the First Commandment; he then followed the order of Exodus 20:17 in the Greek Septuagint and Deuteronomy 5:21 for the Ninth and Tenth Commandments.
